

# Angel Izzy Dolls

a free knitting pattern by Esther Braithwaite

## Materials

Model is knit in Stylecraft Special DK on 2.75mm dpns

## Skills Required

Knitting in the round on dpns  
Knit stitches required (YO, K2tog, SS, PSSO)  
Basic crochet (chain stitch, single crochet, slip stitch)

## Basic Body (work in stocking stitch throughout)

Cast on 32 Sts. Arrange evenly on 4 needles

### SHOES

Rows 1-4 Knit in white

### LEGS

Rows 5-15 Knit in tan

### BODICE

Rows 16-30 Knit in white

### FACE

Rows 31-38 Knit in tan

### HAIR

Rows 39-42 Knit in yellow

### Begin Shaping for Top of Head

Row 43 K1, \*Knit 4 K2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, K1.

Row 44 (and alternate even rows) Knit

Row 45 K1, \* Knit 3 K2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, K1.



Row 47 K1, \* Knit 2, K2 tog, repeat from \*to last stitch, K1.

Row 49 K1, \* Knit 1, K2 tog, repeat from \*to last stitch, K1.

Row 50 K1, \* K2 tog, repeat from \*to last stitch, K1.

Draw yarn through remaining stitches and pull to close. Secure yarn.

## Skirt

### *Lace Skirt (Option A)*

Pick up 32 stitches around the doll's waist. Join skirt color. **With doll held upside down**, work the skirt as follows:

### Set Up:

Row 1 Kfb twice, \*K1, Kfb. Repeat from \*around (49 stitches)

Row 2 Knit. Arrange stitches on 4 dpns (14,14,14,7)

This pattern is adapted from the Izzy Doll patterns available freely online for charity knitting. The pattern is free for personal use, not for sale or profit.

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Lace Pattern (see lace chart):

Row 3 K1 K2tog YO K1 YO S1 K1 PSSO K1.

Repeat around.

Row 4 Knit

Row 5 K2tog YO K3 YO S1 K1 PSSO.

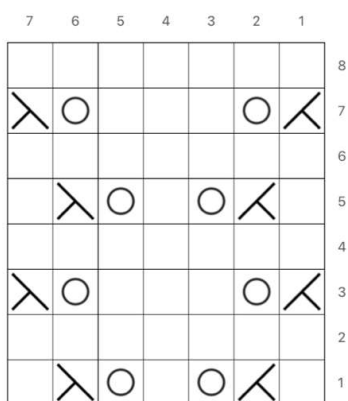
Repeat around.

Row 6 Knit

Repeat Lace pattern once more for knee length dress, or twice more for floor-length gown.

Row 15 Purl.

Row 16 Cast off purlwise.

## Wings

For the wings, I used Cynthia Banessa's "Beautiful Free Crochet Angel Pattern" using DK yarn and a 3.25mm hook.

## To Finish Doll

Stuff head. Weave a strand of matching yarn across the first face row. - Draw up to form neck and secure ends.

Repeat for body and sew up bottom.

Using long tail from cast on, define legs with tiny backstitches through all layers - from bottom to a little before waistline.

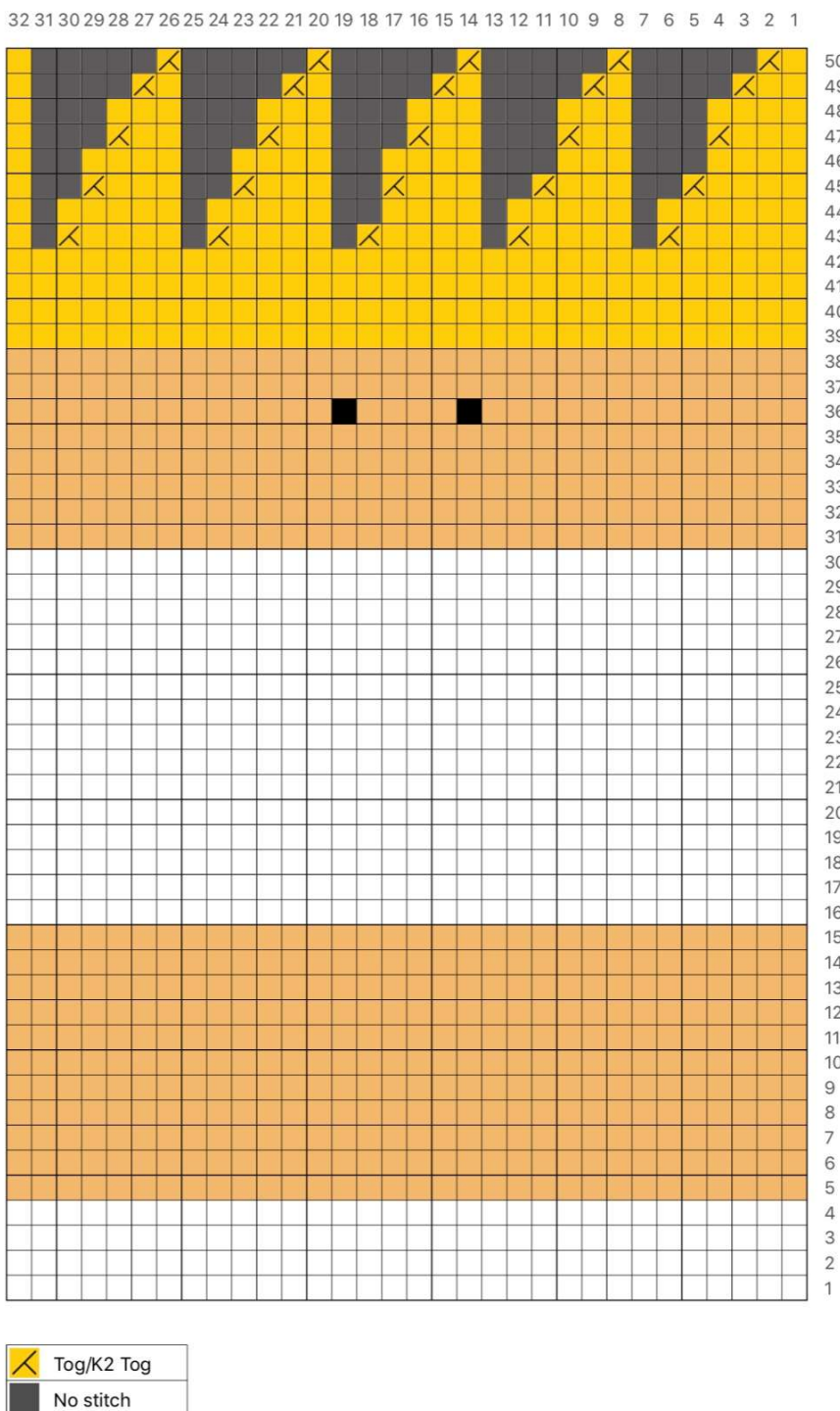
Form arms in same way from waist to two rows before neck.

Attach wings to centre back.

Embroider face and add hair.

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
